**Extrait des instructions d'arpentage
de D.S. Ballantyne, 25 mai 1843**

Surveyor General

Additional

In effecting the subdivision as directed in the foregoing instructions, you will intersect the improvements of squatters settled in these Townships as well as in other parts of the Saguenay County, whose claims will fall under the consideration of Government for purchase or otherwise. You will in that case make a special Survey of the boundaries of the land or lands settled upon; on which occasion you may deviate, but as little as circumstances will admit, - from the bearing of the lateral boundaries of lots represented on the diagram; adopting, however, as much as possible in matters of uncleared land but intended to form the purchase of a lot connected with the improved part, a uniform bearing; and accordingly plant proper marks and transmit reports of Survey of each case for the information of Government.
